

Friday - Arrive at the camp by 6:30 pm Prep for Breakfast. Done between 7:30-8:00.

Saturday - 5:30 am - Arrive at camp for prep, cooking and service of Breakfast. Breakfast is served around 7 am and lasts about an hour. Then we'll clean up and prep for lunch. Breakfast is usually scrambled eggs, a choice of meats, biscuits and gravy, cereal, fruit, coffee. All simple things to serve.

Lunch will be served at approximately noon. Same as before, we will need to finish any prep work, cook, serve, and clean up. I believe in the past lunch has been burgers and hotdogs. We usually serve a smaller group at lunch.

All the food, equipment and supplies are provided by the camp. We only supply the bodies for the work. This is a commercial kitchen and two (2) large serving areas.

Ken, Camp Maintenance Supervisor, said we should be done by 2:30 pm.

The other change in the plan is the sleeping arrangements. Originally, we were going to have rooms where we could stay with two people to a room. Unfortunately, those housing units were deemed a hazard due to asbestos and have been torn down.

There are sleeping facilities (free of charge), but it is bunk style with boys on one side and girls on another w/ communal baths.

Some of us will end up getting rooms in town. They usually give us a great rate (approximately \$100 per night) for TLC events. Most of the time we end up at the YO Hotel for their prime rib buffet (and possibly an adult beverage) on Friday evening.

We will be feeding approximately 300 Lions and their friends/family members who are all up there to assist in improving the camp. They will have jobs from cleaning facilities to building structures and everything in between.

They ask us to be involved with the camp meal as it is one of the more difficult positions to fill.

In the early afternoon, after the work has been completed, the camp staff will load us up in golf carts and give tours around the facility. If you've never been, you will be in shock at all they have to offer.
