Message from Thomas Matschek via SignUp.com

Dear Volunteers,

Here's a message from your SignUp.com organizer, Thomas Matschek:

Hello Volunteers for the New Braunfels Evening Lions Club Wurstfest Booth!

Before getting into the administrative details, I want to start by thanking each of you on behalf of our club for supporting our booth!

This is our primary fundraiser of the year, and all proceeds go toward supporting local and state youth programs, community service projects, and other causes — totaling upwards of \$30,000 annually.

We couldn't do this without your support. Thank you again!

ADMINISTRATION

Tickets

1. All volunteers for our booth will receive tickets that cover admission to the festival grounds, free parking, and shuttle service access.
2. This year, all tickets are distributed and tracked via an e-ticket system. You will not receive a physical ticket — each ticket is a QR code.
3. I'm currently distributing tickets, and everyone should have theirs by the end of today (Thursday, Nov. 6).
Tickets are sent to the email you used when signing up and, if provided, also to your cell phone.
The e-ticket system is managed by RoninPOS.
4. Your admission QR code is tied to the number and type of shifts (weekday vs. weekend) you've volunteered for.
5. If you volunteered for multiple positions within one shift and are bringing friends or family under your name, please enter the grounds together.
This allows the gate worker to "swipe" your QR code for the correct number of volunteers.
6. The QR code is labeled "Vendor." This designation gives you access to the free shuttle service and Gate 4 (details below).

Parking and Shuttle Service

1. Wurstfest provides free shuttle service for volunteers.
Shuttles run from the Comal County Fairgrounds, specifically the parking lot behind the rodeo grounds.
 - Enter from the first fairgrounds entrance (across from the cemeteries) when coming up the hill from the river on the loop.
 - The lot should be well-labeled.

2. Shuttle schedule:
 - First Friday – starts at 2:30 PM
 - Saturdays & Sundays – starts at 10:00 AM
 - Weekdays – starts at 3:30 PM
 - Runs until one hour after the festival ends.

We'll ensure everyone can leave the booth in time to catch the last shuttle.

1. You do not need to take the first shuttle for opening shifts — it starts early for festival staff and entertainers.
Plan to arrive at the parking lot about 30 minutes before your scheduled shift.
2. The parking lot will be lit and monitored by security the entire time it's open.
Space availability and traffic have historically not been an issue — it's a great option.

Festival Entrance

1. All attendees must pass through metal detectors and bag screening.
 - If you use a general admission gate, you'll wait in the public line for screening.
 - For weekend shifts, please arrive early — crowds can be large.
2. Volunteers have access to a special gate for anyone with a Wurstfest badge or Vendor QR code.
3. This is Gate 4, located between the Circle Arts Theatre and the Landa Recreation Center.
 - The line here is usually much shorter.
 - Entry is for credentialed volunteers only — friends and family without credentials cannot use this gate.

- Gate 4 is close to the shuttle drop-off point, so we recommend using it if the main gates (like Gate 3) are crowded.
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Booth Details

1. We are in Booth C-9 — the New Braunfels Evening Lions Club.
The Noon Lions Club is right next door.
If you don't see fried Oreos, double-check — you might be in the wrong booth!
 2. Please wear closed-toed shoes.
 3. The work can be busy and a little messy.
Dress comfortably and in clothes that can handle powdered sugar — fancy attire is not recommended.
